PLEASE READ AND SIGN WAIVER: I know that participating or volunteering in a road race/walk/wheelchair event is a potentially hazardous activity. Having read this waiver and knowing these facts, and in consideration of your accepting my entry, I hereby for myself, and anyone entitled to act on my behalf, waive and release the City of Coburg, Lane County, the State of Oregon, Road Runners Club of America, Eclectic Edge Racing, Coburg Hills Running LLC, the charities receiving proceeds from the event and all sponsors, their representatives and successors, directors, officers, employees, volunteers, agents, and any other personnel in any way assisting or connected with this event from all claims or liabilities of any kind arising out of my participation in this event even though that liability may arise out of negligence, or carelessness on the part of the persons named on this waiver. - Day of race, starting at 5:45am in Norma Pfeiffer Park (Diamond & E. McKenzie St.) downtown Coburg OR

**Event History and Charity:** Run in the Country started out 12 years ago to be an event “designed by runners, for runners.” We continue to make all of our decisions based on making the race better for the participants. We donate profits from the event to charities, primarily those focused on youth health and fitness. Organizations providing 4 or more volunteers to the race receive priority when we choose where the profits will be directed.

**Awards:**

- Half Marathon Run-top 3 overall male and female, plus 3 deep for age groups in 5-year increments. Overall winners not eligible for age group awards.
- Half Marathon Walk-no awards offered since it is a non-competitive and not officiated.
- Half Marathon Relay-top team in each category.

**Safety Reminders:** Insurance restrictions require us to exclude any wheeled devices (except for racing wheelchairs) from the course. Dogs and baby strollers not allowed. Roads will remain open to traffic and our County permit requires that we run in the direction of traffic (not against it).

**Volunteers:** We can always use more volunteers! To volunteer email us at [racedirector@RunInTheCountry.com](mailto:racedirector@RunInTheCountry.com). A good rule of thumb: run five and volunteer for one.

**Course:** This flat and fast course winds through Coburg and then moves into the countryside. It follows a loop created by Bottom Loop Rd. on the south, Powerline Rd. on the west, Herman Rd. on the north and N. Coburg Rd. on the east. The finish line will close at 10:00 AM. 6 Aid Stations w/ Porta Potties at each.

**Events:**

**Half Marathon Non-Competitive Walk:**

6am start on N. Willamette Street/E. McKenzie intersection next to Coburg’s Pavilion Park. This start time is for walkers only; it is not intended to be an early start option for runners.

**Half Marathon Run:**

7am start at the same location as the Half Marathon Walk.

**Half Marathon Relay:**

7am start at the same location as the Half Marathon Walk. Form a team of any three individuals. The first two legs are 5 miles in length, while the final leg is a 5K. Teams provide their own shuttle. Exchange locations and more details will be in the packet.

**Relay Divisions include:**

- Family-All members related by blood or marriage
- Corporate-All members employed by the same organization.
- High School-All members enrolled in same high school in upcoming school year.
- Super Masters-Combined age is over 180.
- Masters Men-All members 40 or older
- Masters Women-All members 40 or older
- Coed Open-At least one female member
- Open Men-All men
- Open Women-All women

**Kids Fun Run:** 9:45am start on N. Harrison/E. McKenzie intersection. This non-competitive event makes a 400m loop around Norma Pfeiffer Park where the kids cross the main finish line and receive a special award. Registration required. FREE!

**Post-Race Awards Ceremony and Raffle:**

Approximately 9:55am in Coburg’s Norma Pfeiffer Park, near the finish line. Awards will be presented for race and age group winners. All participants and volunteers are eligible for the raffle drawings. Must be present to win.

**Run With The Race Directors:**

Saturday, 7/18/09, 7am on the Half Marathon course for all volunteers and sponsors who are unable to race on Sunday. This is a no cost, no frills, no aid (bring your own water), non-timed fun run.

**Directions:** All events start in downtown Coburg, Oregon. From the north or south, take I-5 to exit #199, Coburg National Historic District, approximately 7 miles north of Eugene. Head west from the I-5 exit on Pearl approximately 1 mile. Norma Pfeiffer Park is 1 block north of Pearl between Diamond and Harrison. Please respect our neighbors by keeping the noise down and not parking on private property.
